### **Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (11-13 August), Gourmet Zone, HK International Tea Fair (11-13 August), Home Delights Expo & Beauty and Wellness Expo 2022 Combo Ticket: HK\$40 per person**

- Combo Tickets are available for sale at 01 Space e-ticketing platform, all 7-11 Convenience Stores, Circle K Convenience Stores, HK Ticketing, Neigbuy and Octopus App.
- Ticket holder has admission to the Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (11-13 August), Gourmet Zone, HK International Tea Fair (11-13 August), Home Delights Expo and Beauty and Wellness Expo on the same day.
- Tourists ticket concession: Tourists can purchase HK\$30 Concessionary Combo Ticket upon presentation of valid travel documents at fairground.

### **Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (11-13 August), HK International Tea Fair (11-13 August), Home Delights Expo and Beauty and Wellness Expo 2022 Single Ticket: HK\$25 per person**

- Single Tickets are available for sale at 01 Space e-ticketing platform, all 7-11 Convenience Stores, Circle K Convenience Stores, HK Ticketing, Neigbuy and Octopus App, or pay directly by Octopus for admission at the hall entrances.
- Ticket Holder has admission to the Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (11-13 August), HK International Tea Fair (11-13 August), Home Delights Expo and Beauty and Wellness Expo on the same day.
- Ticket concession for persons with disabilities: Holder of the "Registration Card for Persons with Disabilities" issued by the Labour and Welfare Bureau can be admitted to the fair with HK\$10 at fairground.
- Tourists ticket concession: Tourists can purchase HK\$20 Concessionary Single Ticket upon presentation of valid travel documents at fairground.
- On 11-14 August 2022, Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (11-13 August), HK International Tea Fair (11-13 August), Home Delights Expo and Beauty and Wellness Expo Single Ticket holder can pay a top-up fee of HK\$15 for the admission of Gourmet Zone on the same day. Visitors shall pay directly by Octopus for admission at the Hall 3BC Entrance. Same top-up admission fee for tourist. Top-up admission fee for holders of the "Registration Card for Persons with Disabilities" issued by the Labour and Welfare Bureau is HK\$10.

- Pay directly by Octopus for admission at the hall entrances only.
- Ticket Holder has admission to the Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (except 13-15 August), HK International Tea Fair (except 13-15 August), Home Delights Expo and Beauty and Wellness Expo after 6:00pm on 11-14 August 2022 on the same day.
- Same admission fee for tourist and persons with disabilities.
- Night Ticket holder can pay a top-up fee of HK\$15 for the admission of Gourmet Zone on the same day. Visitors shall pay directly by Octopus for admission at the Hall 3BC Entrance. Same top-up admission fee for tourist. Top-up admission fee for holders of the "Registration Card for Persons with Disabilities" issued by the Labour and Welfare Bureau is HK\$10.

### **Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (11-13 August), HK International Tea Fair (11-13 August), Home Delights Expo & Beauty and Wellness Expo 2022 Morning Admission Ticket: HK\$10 per person**

- Pay directly by Octopus for admission at the hall entrances only.
- Ticket Holder has admission to the Food Expo Public Hall, Trade Zone (except 13-15 August), HK International Tea Fair (except 13-15 August), Home Delights Expo & Beauty and Wellness Expo before 12 noon on 11, 12 and 15 August 2022 on the same day.
- Same admission fee for tourist and persons with disabilities.
- Morning Ticket holder can pay a top-up fee of HK\$15 for the admission of Gourmet Zone on the same day (except 15 August). Visitors shall pay directly by Octopus for admission at the Hall 3BC Entrance. Top-up admission fee for holders of the "Registration Card for Persons with Disabilities" issued by the Labour and Welfare Bureau is HK\$10.

Remarks:

- Free admission for children aged 3 or below and senior citizens aged 65 or above.
- There will be no admission to the venue 45 minutes prior to daily closing time of the Expo.
- No re-entry is allowed.
- Ticket holder must agree to observe and comply Visitor's Rules and Regulations.

- Do not enter the fairground if you are in close contact with any person who is a confirmed or preliminary positive case of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) infection, or you are currently under compulsory quarantine or medical surveillance order by the Department of Health of Hong Kong.
- All visitors must comply with the requirement of the Vaccine Pass.
- The Organiser reserves the right to reject admission should the ticket holder fail to comply with the Regulations of the Organiser.
- Visitors to the Fair must satisfy themselves with the quality, condition, fitness, detail or otherwise of every product or service before trial or purchase. The Organiser does not assume any responsibility for the products or service offered and sold by the exhibitors.
- No liquor for person under the age of 18.
- Admission tickets are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged for cash or other admission tickets. Resale of this ticket constitutes an offence under Hong Kong Law.
